

Westside Housing COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

Contractor notice

Update: 7 January 2022

Westside have implemented measures to keep our staff, tenants, contractors and the community safe. This is a shared responsibility with you.

Vaccinations

Westside has introduced a requirement for COVID-19 vaccinations for maintenance contractors entering occupied homes and our office from 1 February 2022.

We ask that you please return the COVID-19 Vaccination Declaration signed by your organisations management representative to maintenance@westsidehousing.org.au by 1 February 2022.

Westside requires all contractors attending Westside's office or occupied homes to:

- Not attend if they are not vaccinated
- Not attend if they answer YES to any of the SA Health questions
- Wear a mask when interacting with other people
- If tenants refuse to wear a mask, you can ask that they wait outside while you undertake the work. If they refuse you may choose to continue to work or leave depending on the level of risk you have assessed
- Follow your COVID safe procedures and all COVID safe practices, including:
 - Washing / sanitising hands immediately before and after entering / exiting properties.
 - Maintain physical distancing of 1.5m apart.
- Try to limit the time indoors to <15 minutes, where possible.
- Before entry, ask the following questions:
 1. Are you unwell and experiencing any COVID symptoms?
 2. Have you tested positive or been asked to self-isolate?

Contractors engaged by Westside are responsible for ensuring and certifying that all of their workers attending Westside properties meet these requirements.
