### What is the program?

Housing SA, in partnership with not-for-profit training provider SYC (RTO 40053), is offering a building and construction course in June 2020.

The course runs full-time for 10 weeks and aims to provide skills and training to prepare participants for job opportunities with builders and contractors used by Housing SA.

Successful graduates of the course will achieve:

- ✓ (FSK20113) Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways incorporating accredited units from (CPC20112) Certificate II in Construction including:
- ✓ (CPCCCM1012A) Work effectively and sustainably in the construction industry
- ✓ (CPCCCM2005B) Use construction tools and equipment

- Motivated and committed to gain work in the building and construction industry
- Able to pass a pre-employment medical, including drug and alcohol testing. *There will be random drug and alcohol testing within the course.*
- Physically fit

### Do you?

- Have a White Card? It is required to be able to work at a live construction site\*
- Have access to the internet and a computer/device suitable for on-line learning?

- On-the-job construction training at a Housing SA property in East Street, Brompton
